NEHU FOR FAMILY CONSUMPTION

§13-90-1 Prohibited activities

§13-90-2 Penalty

Historical Note: Chapter 90 of Title 13 is based substantially upon Regulation 25 of the Division of Fish and Game, Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii. [Eff. 3/28/58; am 10/6/58; R MAY 26 1981 ]

§13-90-1 Prohibited activities. No person shall catch, take, possess, or remove nehu (Stolephorus purpureus) from the waters of the State except for family consumption or other purposes, provided that:

- (1) Any small mesh net used shall not exceed fifty feet (15.24 meters) in length; and
- (2) Not more than one gallon (3.79 liters) of nehu is taken per day. [Eff: MAY 26 1981 ] (Auth: HRS §187A-5) (Imp: HRS §§187A-5, 188-45)

§13-90-2 Penalty. A person violating the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished as provided by law. [Eff: MAY 26 1981] (Auth: HRS §187A-5) (Imp: HRS §188-70)
