

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) will hold public hearings on the proposed amendments to Title 13, Hawaii Administrative Rules, as they pertain to vehicle parking fees and thrill craft education requirements occurring in state small boat harbors, facilities, and near shore waters. Section 13-233-26 clarifies that vehicle parking rates will be set at either equal to or less than established State or County rates in the County where the parking fees are applied and Section 13-256-16 clarifies that the thrill craft education requirement meets the mandatory education requirement of Section 13-244-15.5 as long as the person only operates thrill craft. Written statements may be submitted at the public hearings or to the Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation at 333 Queen Street, Suite 300, Honolulu, HI 96813, prior to the hearing date.
