



Application Instructions for the  
**2015 Puu Waawaa Mauka Archery Ungulate Control Program**  
**Typical Ram Incentive Hunt**

1. The 2014 Puu Waawaa Mauka Archery Ungulate Control Program, **Typical Ram Incentive Hunt** will run for six weekends beginning February 7, 2015 through March 15, 2015. To prevent overcrowded hunting conditions, a public drawing will be held to assign hunter groups one weekend. Each hunter group that is drawn will be permitted to hunt two consecutive days (one weekend) in the Mauka area within Puu Waawaa.
2. There will be a bag limit of one (1) typical ram **ONLY AFTER** one (1) non-typical ram has been harvested and checked-out by the same permittee. There will be no bag limit on feral goats of either sex. Deboning of game **will not** be permitted. Animals must be checked out whole and entrails maybe cleaned with attached genitalia.
3. A maximum of **five (5)** hunters may apply together as a hunting group. **All hunters of each hunting group must be entered on a single application form.** (Please see the reverse side). Do not staple other application forms together. Hunters under the age of 16 must be included in a group with an adult hunting holding a valid Hawaii Hunting license.
4. Be sure to **PRINT all information** clearly in the spaces provided for **each** hunter, using **each hunter's own personal mailing address**. The correct **2015 Hawaii Hunting License number is required** for **each** hunter on the application form. Failure to provide the **2015 Hawaii Hunting License number** will disqualify that hunter applicant from the lottery held to assign hunting dates.
5. **Please include: One self-addressed stamped envelope per-hunter on the application.** Information will be mailed to the lead applicant following the public drawing.
6. The **DEADLINE** for all applications to be submitted to the **Division of Forestry and Wildlife Office, 66-1220 A Lalamilo Road, Kamuela HI. 96743 at 3:30 pm on Wednesday, September 3, 2014** (this is when the DOFAW office will close) or postmarked by that by the U.S. Postal Service.
7. The **PUBLIC DRAWING** to assign hunting date(s) and hunting area(s) for all qualified applicants for the 2014 Puu Waawaa Mauka Ungulate Control Program will be held in the Kamuela Hunter Education Office, 66-1220 D Lalamilo Road, Kamuela, HI. 96743 on **Wednesday, September 10, 2014 at 11:00 am**. Hunters may attend the drawing to witness the results. Results will be mailed, made available on-line, and will be available in the Kamuela Office.
8. In the case of duplicate hunter applications received, the **first** application received will be entered into the lottery to assign hunting date(s)/area(s). Duplicate applications will not be considered.
9. All Hunters must sign-in and sign-out at the Puu Waawaa Hunter Checking Station between 5 am and 2 pm on their assigned date(s) and must check-out by 6 pm. Vehicle passes will be given at the hunter check station. Standbys will be allowed after 10am as slots are available. Non-permittees and ATVs are not allowed. For safety purposes, a maximum thirty (30) permittees will be allowed per day in the Mauka section.
10. All other provisions of Title 13, Chapter 123 Rules Regulating Game Mammal Hunting, including signing in and out at a hunter checking station, safety zones, legal hunting hours and lawful transportation of firearms apply.
