
I am pleased to inform you that on March 10, 2000, the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) approved your CDUA for construction of a 600,000 water reservoir and cover for an existing 5 million gallon reservoir at Kulani Correctional Facility, South Hilo District, Hawaii County, subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant, his successors and assigns, shall comply with all of the standard conditions for Conservation District Use Permits listed in Chapter 13-5-42(a), Hawaii Administrative Rules;
2. The applicant shall comply with all applicable statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations of the federal, state, and county governments, and applicable parts of Chapter 13-5, HAR;
3. The applicant, his successors and assigns, shall comply with all applicable Department of Health administrative rules;
4. All representations relative to mitigation set forth in the accepted environmental assessment or impact statement for the proposed use are incorporated as conditions of this permit;
5. During the construction period, the applicant shall establish construction vehicle and equipment cleaning stations well away from the project site and use on-site soils and gravel for construction;
6. The applicant shall develop and implement an invasive species monitoring strategy with the assistance of the Biological Resources Division, U.S. Geological Survey and the Olaa-Kilauea Management Group. Surveys shall be conducted by qualified personnel at least four times a year for at least two years;

7. Where any interference, nuisance, or harm may be caused, or hazard established by the use, the applicant shall be required to take measures to minimize or eliminate the interference, nuisance, harm, or hazard;
8. Other terms and conditions as prescribed by the chairperson; and
9. Failure to comply with any of these conditions shall render this permit void.
