Pet dogs and cats still retain their natural instinct to kill. This is why it is important for everyone to play their part to protect wildlife. Laysan albatross nest along coastal areas on Kauai. Please help protect these majestic birds by following these simple rules:

- Keep dogs leashed during walks along coastal areas
- Keep pets indoors, kenneled or fenced in your property
- Stay on walk paths and observe seabird nesting signs
- Report loose dogs or incidents of bird injury and mortality to:
