



A Draft Board Submittal was sent out for review and comments to the following agencies: Department of Health, Department of Aquatic Resources, Historic Preservation Division, Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands, Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation, Division of Conservation and Resource Enforcement, Office of Hawaii Affairs, Kauai County Planning Division and the Kauai County Parks and Recreation Division.

Exemption Determination:

After reviewing HAR § 11-200-(8), DLNR has concluded that the activities under this permit would have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and that issuance of the permit is categorically exempt from the requirement to prepare an environmental assessment.

According to the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources, as Reviewed approved by the Environmental Council on June 5, 2015, Exemption Class No.1, "Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing," Item 51, "Permits, licenses, registrations, and rights-of-entry issued by the Department that are routine in nature, involving negligible impacts beyond that previously existing."

Conclusion:

It is recommended that the Board declare that this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is presumed to be exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
