## Kona Crab and Lobster Closed Season Sales License Specific Terms and Conditions

The *licensee* refers to any person or business issued a kona crab and lobster closed season sales license. The kona crab and lobster closed season sales license allows the licensee to sell or serve during closed seasons, kona crab or lobster that were legally caught from State waters during the open season.

## I understand that:

- 1. Licenses issued to businesses may not be transferred to another business, but employees may use the license.
- 2. It is illegal to sell or serve kona crab and lobster during the closed season, without a valid kona crab and lobster closed season sales license.
- 3. I may only sell or serve kona crab and lobster if they were legally caught during the open season in State waters.
- 4. I must have a separate license for each business or store operation.
- 5. Upon demand of any officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State, I must present receipts documenting from whom I bought the kona crab and lobster and to whom it was resold (other businesses).
- 6. I must keep these receipts for one year from the date of sale at the place of business where the kona crab and lobster were sold.
- 7. I must pay a license fee of \$50.00.
- 8. I must provide a report of my existing inventory of kona crab and lobsters at the time I apply for or renew my license. DLNR may return any report that is incomplete or incorrectly filled.
