**Special Marine Animal or Product Possession and Sales License**  
**Specific Terms and Conditions**

The *licensee* refers to any person or business issued a special marine animal or product possession and sales license. The special marine animal or product possession and sales license allows the licensee to possess, sell, serve or offer for sale any imported marine life when such marine life are prohibited (closed season, minimum size or bag limit) if taken from State waters. A product is an item made, either in part or whole, from regulated marine life.

I understand that:

1. Licenses issued to businesses may not be transferred to another business, but employees may use the license.
2. It is illegal to possess, sell, serve, or offer for sale any restricted imported marine life without a valid special marine animal or product possession and sales license.
3. I may not take marine life from State waters and sell such marine life in violation of State law, even with this license.
4. I must have a separate license for each business or store operation.
5. Upon demand of any officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State, I must present receipts documenting from whom I bought the imported marine life and to whom it was resold (other businesses).
6. I must keep these receipts for one year from the date of sale at the place of business where the imported product is sold.
7. I must pay a license fee of \$100.00
8. I must provide a report of my existing inventory of imported marine life at the time I apply for or renew my license. DLNR may return any report that is incomplete, or incorrectly filled.
