Proposal to Adopt a New Chapter Under Title 13 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules as Chapter 48.5, "Maunalua Bay Fisheries Management Area, O`ahu"

The proposed rules would:

- Outline the purpose of the Maunalua Bay Fisheries Management Area (FMA), O'ahu: 1)
- 2) Provide definitions for key terms;
- 3) Establish and delineate the boundaries for the Maunalua FMA;
- Describe permitted and prohibited activities within the Maunalua FMA, including: 4)
  - a. Restrictions on the take and/or possession of `alakuma, horned helmet, Triton's trumpet, ula (spiny lobster), and ula pāpapa (slipper lobster)
  - b. Restrictions on the use or possession of spears while diving between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- 5) Carve out an exception for vessels with restricted species or gear in active transit through the Maunalua FMA;
- Establish the administrative and criminal penalties for violations of this chapter; and 6)
- 7) Recognize the State's asset forfeiture authority as an enforcement tool for violations of this chapter.
