***AGENDA ITEM 6, Additional Information**

The Kāneʻohe Bay Regional Council will form a Temporary Committee to continue the process of renewing the Kāneʻohe Bay Master Plan. The Heʻeia National Estuary Research Reserve (NERR) will contract a facilitator/planner to lead group discussions. The Temporary Committee will leave in place the broad community consensus achieved in the 1992 plan on limiting commercial activity, focusing updates on:

- New organizations or partnerships that currently or could potentially play a role in stewarding the bay
- New statutes, administrative rules, zoning changes, or planning documents affecting the bay
- New knowledge of environmental threats to the bay, including climate change
- New educational strategies to assist with the implementation of the plan
- New understanding of Hawaiian knowledge and practices that may guide management efforts

The Temporary Committee will come up with a list of recommended updates to the plan to present to the Council.
