NOTICE OF RULEMAKING USING HRS § 183D-3(b), ADAPTIVE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

Effective March 18, 2024

Adaptive Management Measures by formal board action pursuant to section 183D-3(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to temporarily amend Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) Title 13 chapter 123- Rules Regulating Game Mammal Hunting and Title 13 chapter 122- Rules Regulating Game Bird Hunting, Field Trials, and Commercial Shooting Preserves.

- 1. HAR Chapter 13-123 ("RULES REGULATING GAME MAMMAL HUNTING"), has Amended EXHIBIT 11, "Game mammals to be taken, means of take, daily bag limits, hunting periods, hunting days, and special conditions for hunting on the island of Hawaii" See exhibits below.
- 2. HAR Chapter 13-122 ("RULES REGULATING GAME GAME BIRD HUNTING, FIELD TRIALS, AND COMMERICAL SHOOTING PRESERVES") has Amended EXHIBIT 1, "Game birds to be taken, means of take, daily bag limits, hunting periods, hunting days, and special conditions for hunting on the island of Hawaii."

Rules made under HRS section 183D-3(b) required the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) to find timely adoption necessary to implement effective and adaptive management measures in response to rapidly changing resource conditions. The rule(s) adopted shall be effective no longer than two years, with one-year extensions subject to legislative approval and renewal by the Board.

Each rule adopted, amended, or repealed under this authority shall become effective ten (10) days after formal action by the Board, which was conducted on March 8, 2024, provided that if a later effective date is specified in the rule, the later date shall be the effective date. Final rules are posted at https://dlnr.hawaii.gov/dofaw/rules/ and will remain posted during the duration they are in effect.

*NOTE: Hunting tags for the Puuwaawaa and the Puu Anahulu hunting units became available on January 1, 2024. Adaptive management rule changes for these areas will go into effect at the end of the tagged hunting season, which falls on or around September 23, 2024. After that, the above adaptive management rule changes will go into effect. This honors hunters who have already purchased their hunting tags for the season.




Figure 1. Exhibit 12 Chapter 13-123 p. 9 of 12.

Current maps of Hawaii Island Public Hunting Areas for Game Mammals. See Figures 1-5.

Unit A on the island of Hawai'i covers approximately 65,000 acres and consists of the Mauna Kea Forest Reserve and Game Management Area lying north of Daniel K. Inouye HWY, HAR § 13-123-20 (a) (2015). See Figure 1.




Figure 2. Exhibit 12 Chapter 13-123 p. 5 of 12.




Figure 3. Exhibit 12 Chapter 13-123 p. 8 of 12




Figure 4. Exhibit 12 Chapter 13-123 p. 3 of 12




Figure 5. Exhibit 2 Chapter 13-122 p. 4 of 12.

These rules are subject to administrative penalties as provided by section 183D-12, HRS.

Adaptive management rule changes for these areas will go into effect at the end of the tagged hunting season, which falls on or around September 23, 2024. After that, the above adaptive management rule changes will go into effect. This honors hunters who have already purchased their hunting tags for the season.
