

How to Play Growing Up Nēnē

1. Each player creates a game piece and places it on the eggs at the start of the game board.
2. To determine the order of players, have each player roll the die. The player with the highest number will go first. The players with the next highest numbers will follow.
3. Each player rolls the die in turn, and moves the game piece the number of spaces indicated by the die. If the player lands on a card space, the player must pick up a card, read it aloud, show the photo on the card to the other players, and follow the instructions on the card. If the player lands on an illustrated space, the player will skip a turn or roll again depending on the instructions at that space.
4. If the player lands on:
The scenic route: The brown path allows the player to skip a set of spaces. The player will end at the bottom of the path and remain there until their next turn.
Toxoplasmosis detection: This area skips the player's next turn until the player rolls a "5". Players can have three attempts at a "5" per turn.
