PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Polihale State Park encompasses over 130 acres of sand dunes and beach and is home to many natural and cultural resources that are found only at Polihale.
- State Parks closed the park in September 2020 through September 2022 due to overuse and abuse of the park. The community outreach process began in late 2022.
- Key issues for the conceptual master plan include:
 - Protection of natural, cultural, and historic resources
 - Roadway (do not pave), park access, and parking issues
 - Park facilities

COMMUNITY OUTREACH TO-DATE

- Initial Kick-off Survey (08-09/2022): 1,387 total responses
- Survey follow-up discussions: 10 discussions
- Two Kekaha Open House Community Meetings (01/2023):
 ~75 attendees (estimated, 50 signed in), 250 comments
- Līhu'e Open House Community Meeting (03/2023):
 11 attendees, 35 comments
- Online comment mapping (01/2023 Present): 0 comments
- Project email (08/2022 Present): 20 comments
- Kekaha Draft Plan Community Meeting: ~100 attendees (estimated, 66 signed in), 77 comments




NEXT STEPS
