

# MĀKAHA BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Detour and road closure information for construction work in September 2023


**Aloha!** The Hawai'i State Department of Transportation is replacing two wooden bridges in Mākaha this September. These bridges have served the community since 1937 and need to be replaced for safety purposes.

The construction will require two 72-hour road closures on separate weekends to complete. **Please refer to the two maps on this flyer about the closures.**

- Follow all traffic control signs and allow for additional travel time to reach your destination.
- Special-duty HPD officers will assist with directing traffic and safety procedures.
- Electronic message boards will be posted on roadways to provide closure information.
- Please be advised that the dates for each road closure are subject to change based upon the availability of resources and weather conditions.
- A temporary water outage west of Kili Drive will be necessary for **one night only** between Aug. 29 and Sept. 1. The Board of Water Supply will notify residents affected by this service disruption.
- Residents near the two bridges should anticipate increased noise levels during work hours.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we complete this essential public safety work for the Mākaha community. **Mahalo.**

## IMPORTANT ACCESS/CLOSURE INFORMATION

- Both directions of Farrington Highway east of Kili Drive and the road closure area will be open between Kili Drive and 'Upena Street.
- **Westbound detour towards Ka'ena Point:** Motorists will be detoured via Mākaha Valley Road, Huipu Drive and Kili Drive to continue on Farrington Highway.
- **Eastbound detour towards Wai'anae:** Motorists will be detoured via Kili Drive, Huipu Drive and Mākaha Valley Road to continue on Farrington Highway.
- Access for Emergency Medical Services will be available throughout the road closure.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Mākaha Beach Park, Kea'au Beach Park, Mākua Beach Park and Keawa'ula Beach/Yokohama Bay will be open.

## IMPORTANT ACCESS/CLOSURE INFORMATION

- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout most of the weekend, except from 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 1, to install the new bridge.
- TheBus service will not be available between Makau Street and Mākua Valley Road.
- Camping and special events will not be permitted at the following parks: Mākaha Beach Park, Kea'au Beach Park, Mākua Beach Park and Keawa'ula Beach/Yokohama Bay.

## FREE SHUTTLE SERVICE

A free, on-demand shuttle service will be available for households from Makau Street to Mākua Valley Road. Households west of Kili Drive will be mailed additional information on available resources during this closure.

## HOTEL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

Residents from the affected neighborhoods wanting to avoid the disruption and road closures created by the construction work will be able to opt into a hotel reimbursement voucher program.

Qualified households must be located on Makau Street, Lawai'a Street, Holt Street, Farrington Highway west of Kili Drive, Kea'au Homestead Road, and Mākua Valley Road.

**Proof of address must be provided to be eligible.**


