Project Info

The Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, is launching the Sand Island State Recreation Area Historic Properties Treatment Project to determine the future of five aging World War II - era structures. Led by G70, the project will assess the condition of these historic properties and invite the community to share input on potential options such as preservation, restoration, adaptive reuse, relocation, or demolition. Virtual public meetings will offer opportunities for residents, park users, and stakeholders to help guide decisions that honor Sand Island's unique history and reflect community values.

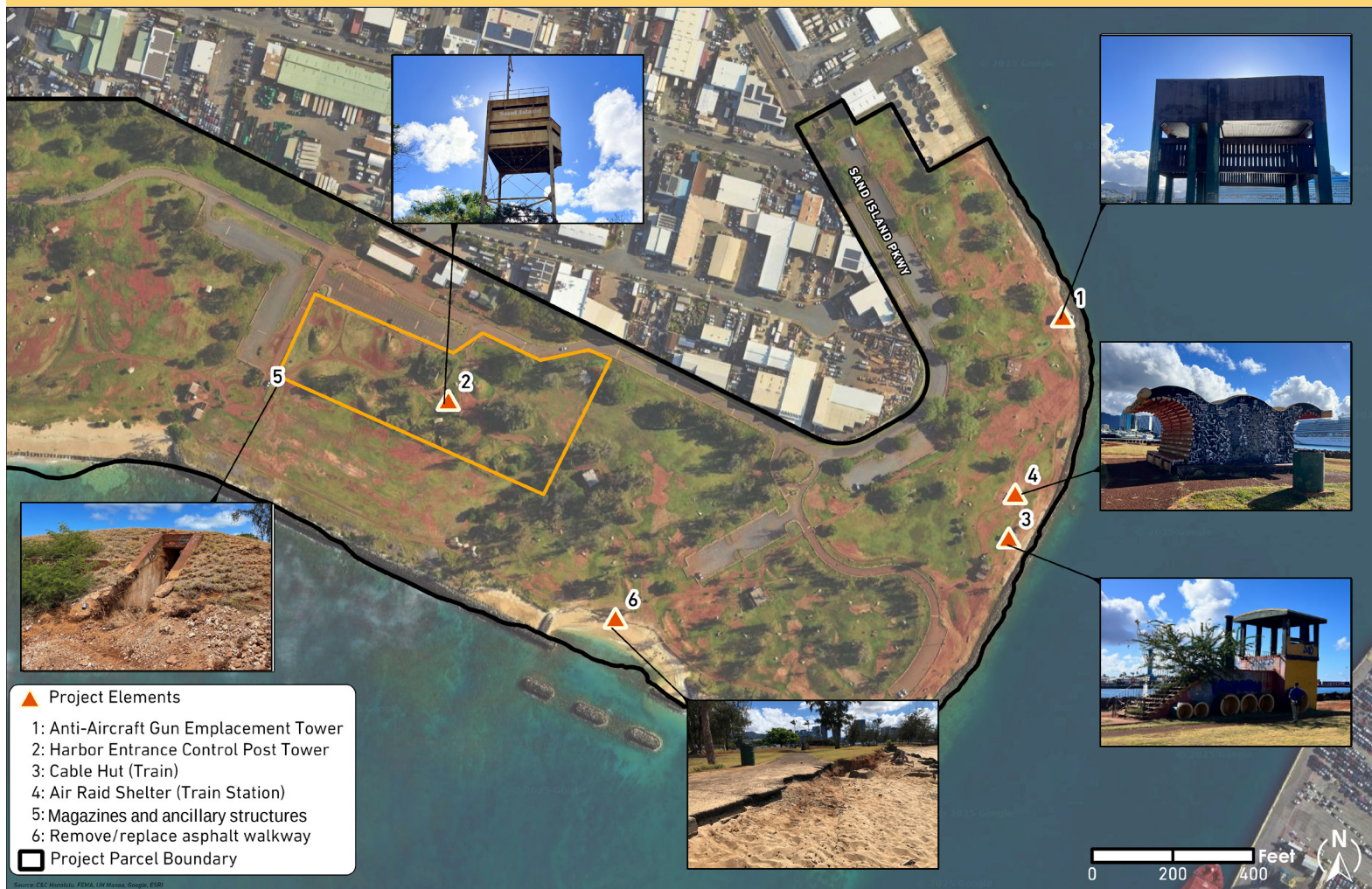
