

PUBLIC: How to Update or Cancel Your Ka'ena Point SUP Permit



Ka'ena Point State Park SUP applications and gate codes **HAVE MOVED TO THIS NEW SITE**. Any accounts made on other sites have not been carried over and are not valid on this platform.

If you are a returning applicant from 2025, you will need to make a NEW ACCOUNT.

All applicants will need to create an account in order to apply. To access the Gate Code in the future, you will need to log in using the same account.

How to Submit Information Update for Existing Permit



Submitting an Information Update means updating the information on one of your Active permits in the system. You will need to have at least one Active permit to update. **If you submit an Information Update between October - December of the current year and it is approved, your permit will also renew for another year.**

If your new decal and permit are approved, you will receive a confirmation email from noreply@hi.accessgov.com. Be sure to have both the new permit and the new decal adhered on your vehicle when visiting Ka'ena Point State Park.



How to Cancel a SUP Permit



Every person/account is limited to two registered vehicles only, with additional vehicles only permitted on a case by case basis. If a vehicle is no longer in use, we recommend cancelling the permit to free up a vehicle slot.

If you plan to be or are no longer in ownership of a vehicle in your account, it is recommended to cancel that vehicle's permit.
