Executive Grder No.

Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes

By this Exerctive Order. I, the undersigned. Covernor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR NATURAL AREA RESERVES, to be under the control and management of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, being the lands situate at Kaohe, Hamakua, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, designated as MAUNA KEA ICE AGE NATURAL AREA RESERVE, PART 1, containing an area of 3750.0 Acres, more or less, and PART 2, containing an area of 143.5 Acres, more or less, all more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibits being, respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 18,645 and dated May 4, 1979.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.
