

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 02719

WITHDRAWING PORTION OF LAND FROM OPERATION OF  
GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION DATED JANUARY 3, 1923

WHEREAS, by Governor's Proclamation dated January 3, 1923, certain lands situate in the District of South Hilo, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, were set aside as the Upper Waiakea Forest Reserve with the approval of a majority of the Board of Commissioners of Agriculture and Forestry and of the Commissioner of Public Lands; and

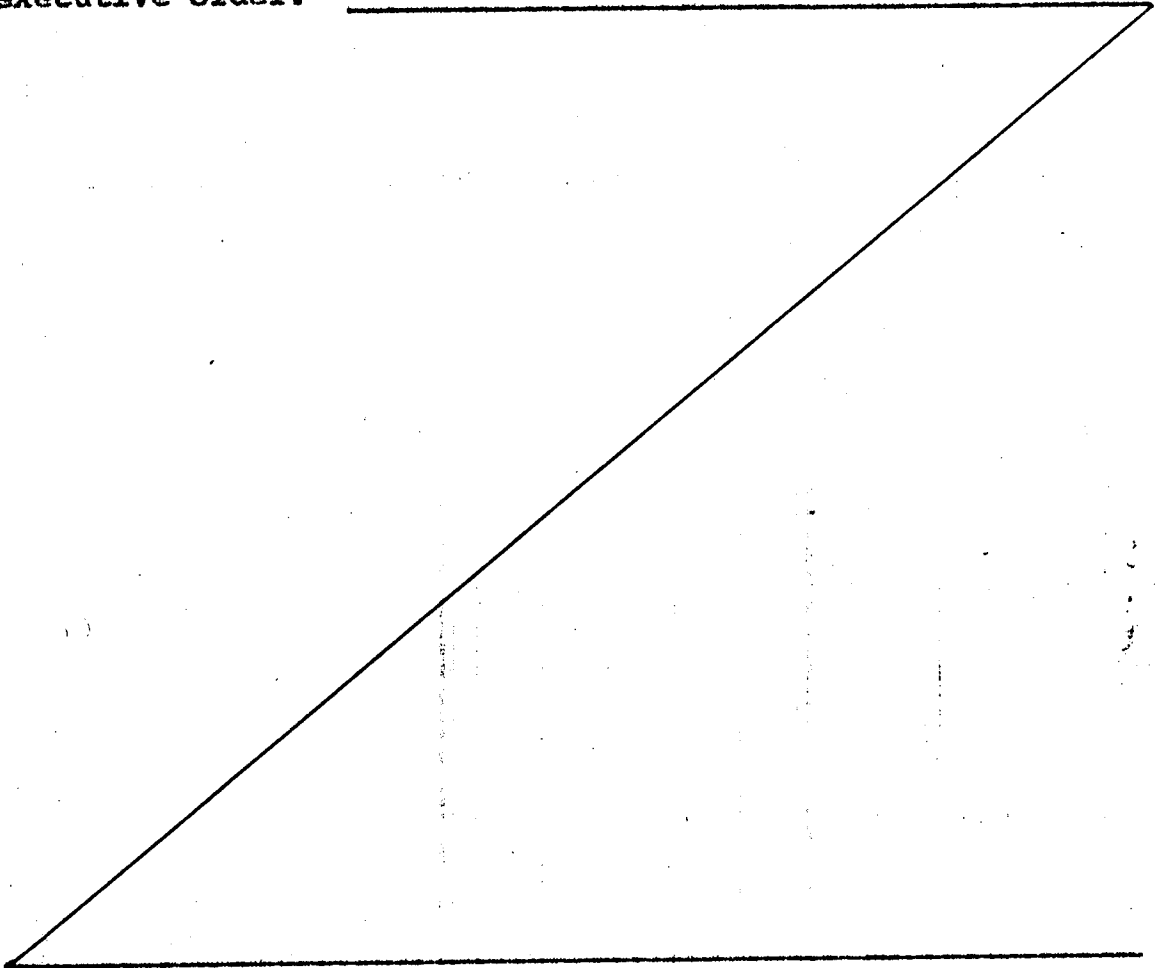
WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources has requested an area within said Proclamation dated January 3, 1923, be withdrawn for the Natural Area Reserves System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources, at its meeting held on July 27, 1973, approved the withdrawal.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI, Acting Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the portion of the Upper Waiakea Forest Reserve, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibits being, respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 16,633 and dated

May 26, 1972, be, and the same is, hereby withdrawn from the operation of Governor's Proclamation dated January 3, 1923.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this executive order.

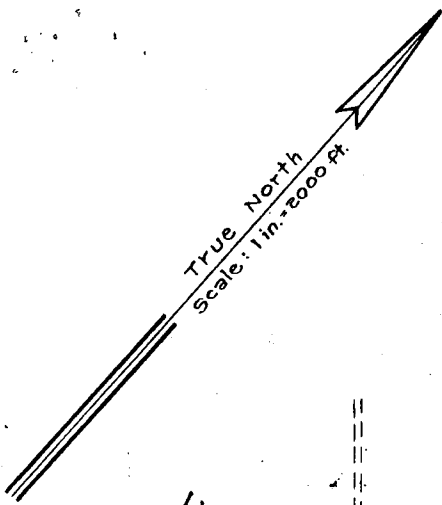

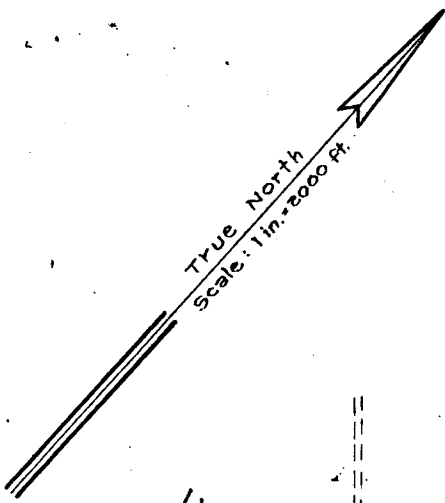

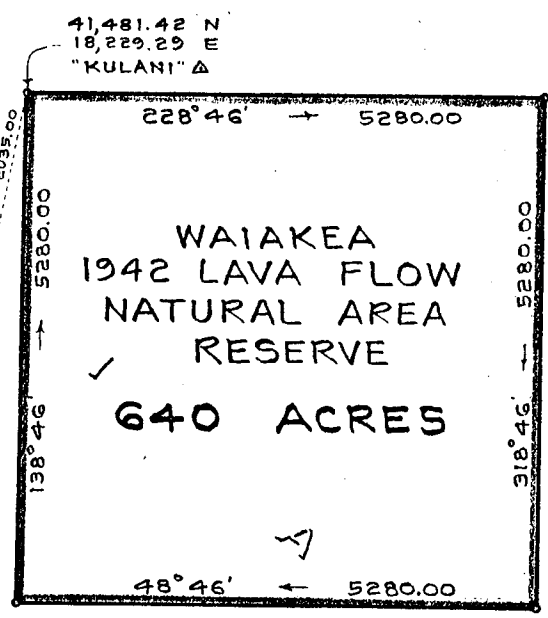

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3359

CANCELLATION OF GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER  
NO. 3103, DATED NOVEMBER 16, 1981

WHEREAS, by Governor's Executive Order No. 3103, dated November 16, 1981, certain lands situate at Puna, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, and designated as "Wao Kele O Puna Natural Area Reserve", containing an area of 16,843.891 acres, more or less, all more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibits being, respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, designated C.S.F. No. 18,647 and dated May 4, 1979, were set aside to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, for "Natural Area Reserve"; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, wishes to utilize said lands covered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3103 dated November 16, 1981, for land exchange purposes for the exploration and development of geothermal energy and, in addition, for the acquisition of lands by the State of Hawaii for natural area purposes; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, at its meeting of October 25, 1985, approved the cancellation of Governor's Executive Order No. 3103;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN WAIHEE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, do hereby order that Executive Order No. 3103, dated November 16, 1981, be and the same is hereby cancelled and declared of no force and effect.

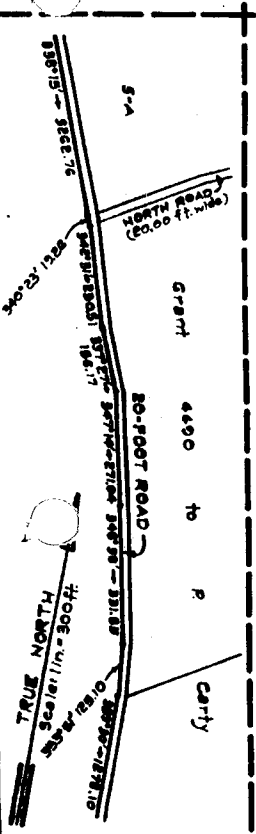
