

Private Landowners' Permission Information

If activities are occurring on private property the following information is needed.

An email will be sent to cynthia.b.king@hawaii.gov directly from the private landowner stating:

-names of persons who will have access to their property

-which Threatened and Endangered species will be worked on and the number of individuals per species

-list which activity will occur on the property:

Collecting propagative materials (seeds, leaves, fruits, flowers, cuttings) and the amount being collected per individual of each species

Propagation- nursery/greenhouse location; number of individuals being propagated per species

Outplanting – list location of secured outplanting sites (include tmks and maps that clearly identify locations); number of individuals being outplanted per species

Monitoring and maintenance of outplants – list names of persons responsible for the monitoring of outplanted individuals and who will be maintaining the outplanting sites

-Special conditions the private landowner would like to add.
