# Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes

By this Exerctive Order, J. the undersigned, Covernor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR NATURAL AREA RESERVE, to be under the control and management of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, being the lands situate at Hanakoa and Hanakapiai, Napali, Island of Kauai, State of Hawaii, and designated as HONO O NA PALI NATURAL AREA RESERVE, containing an area of 3,150 Acres, more or less, all more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibits being, respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated, C.S.F. No. 18,814 and dated January 11, 1980.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by twothirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

Thence southeasterly along the 1200-foot elevation to a point at the middle of Hanakapiai Stream;

Thence southeasterly up along side of steep slope to a point on the boundary between the lands of Haena and Hanakapiai;

Thence southwesterly along the middle of ridge along the lands of
Haena and Wainiha to a point on the
boundary between Halelea Forest Reserve
and Na Pali-Kona Forest Reserve;

Thence westerly along the middle of Kaunuohua ridge along the Government (Crown) Land of Waimea, to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 3,150 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.



WITHDRAWING LAND FROM THE OPERATION OF GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION DATED JUNE 12, 1907

WHEREAS, by Governor's Proclamation dated June 12, 1907, certain lands situate in the districts of Na Pali, Kona and Halelea, Island of Kauai were set aside for the Na Pali-Kona Forest Reserve; and

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WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meeting of September 12, 2008, approved the withdrawal of a portion of land from Governor's Proclamation dated June 12, 1907.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LINDA LINGLE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 183-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Na Pali-Kona Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated June 12, 1907," situate at Waimea, Kauai, Hawaii, containing an area of 486 acres, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 24,702 and dated September 18, 2008, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Proclamation dated June 12, 1907.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.


