



Kaluanui, Koolauloa, Oahu, Hawaii, and identified as "Kaluanui Natural Area Reserve," containing an area of 378.249 acres, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,274 and dated April 10, 2013.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife, Natural Area Reserve System shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.


SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4445

WITHDRAWING LAND FROM THE OPERATION OF
 GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2830
 DATED MARCH 28, 1977

WHEREAS, by Governor's Executive Order No. 2830 dated
 March 28, 1977, certain land situate at Kaluanui, Koolauloa,
 Oahu, Hawaii was set aside for Sacred Falls State Park; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its
 meeting of March 8, 2013, approved the withdrawal of a portion of
 land from Executive Order No. 2830 dated March 28, 1977.




NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Sacred Falls State Park, Governor's Executive Order 2830," situate at Kaluanui, Koolauloa, Oahu, Hawaii, containing an area of 378.249 acres, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 25,273 and dated April 10, 2013, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation of Governor's Executive Order No. 2830 dated March 28, 1977.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.
