


Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes

By this Executive Order, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR NATURAL AREA RESERVE, to be under the control and management of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, being the land situate at Mokuleia, Waialua, Oahu, Hawaii, and designated as PAHOLE NATURAL AREA RESERVE, containing a Gross Area of 660.0 Acres, more or less, and a Net Area of 658.0 Acres, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibits being, respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 18,640 and dated May 4, 1979.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by Majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

PAHOLE NATURAL AREA RESERVE

Mokuleia, Waialua, Oahu, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government Land of Mokuleia.

Beginning at the northeast corner of this parcel of land, the southerly boundary of Grant 1327 to S.N. Emerson and on the westerly side of Mokuleia Trail, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "MOKULEIA 1927" being 12,870.52 feet South and 332.50 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. Along the remainder of Mokuleia Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 31, 1918), along the westerly side of Mokuleia Trail, the direct azimuth and distance being:
36° 30' 4670.00 feet;
2. 318° 20' 1420.00 feet along the remainder of Mokuleia Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 31, 1918);
3. 41° 10' 2010.00 feet along the remainder of Mokuleia Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 31, 1918) to the top of Waianae Range;
4. Thence along the Makua-Keaau Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 19, 1925), along the top of Waianae Range, the direct azimuth and distance being:
135° 00' 8280.00 feet;
5. 241° 50' 1280.00 feet along the remainder of Mokuleia Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 31, 1918);
6. 288° 20' 2894.50 feet along the remainder of Mokuleia Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 31, 1918);
7. 216° 30' 2207.74 feet along the remainder of Mokuleia Forest Reserve (Governor's Proclamation dated December 31, 1918);

8. 284° 35' 45" 3950.00 feet along Grant 1668 to W. Chamberlain, Grant 1328 to C. W. Collins and Grant 1327 to S.N. Emerson, to the point of beginning and containing a GROSS AREA OF 660.0 ACRES AND A NET AREA OF 658.0 ACRES MORE OR LESS after excluding the Camp Site containing an AREA OF 2.0 ACRES.
