

Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes

By this Executive Order, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR a Natural Area Reserve, to be under the control and management of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, and to be designated as the Puu Alii Natural Area Reserve, situate at Waikolu, Kalawao, Molokai, Hawaii, those portions of Government (Crown) Land of Waikolu, containing a gross area of 1,330 acres, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and shown on Exhibit "B", both exhibits being attached hereto and made a part hereof, being a survey description and a survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being C.S.F. No. 20,230 and dated July 8, 1985. This Executive Order is subject to and does hereby reserve to the Board of Land and Natural Resources the right, authority and discretion to use any of the subject lands for water and water tunnel development if needed and so determined by the Board.

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

PUU ALII NATURAL AREA RESERVE

Waikolu, Kalawao, Molokai, Hawaii

Being portion of the Government Land of Waikolu.

Beginning at Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUU ALII" on the top of pali of Pelekunu Valley at the head of the Government land of Waikolu, at the southeast corner of this parcel of land, thence running:-

1. Southwesterly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation. dated September 11, 1912, the boundary follows along the land of Kawela, R.P. 7656, L.C.Aw. 8559-B, Apana 28 to William C. Lunailo to the edge of Waikolu Valley at a place called Hanailolilo;
2. Thence northerly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated September 11, 1912, to a point on the contour line 2500 feet above mean sea level, being also the middle of Waikolu Stream;
3. Thence northerly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated September 11, 1912, the boundary follows along contour line 2500 feet above mean sea level;
4. Thence southeasterly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated September 11, 1912, the boundary follows along contour line 2500 feet above mean sea level to the westerly boundary of the land of Pelekunu, R.P. 7262, L.C.Aw. 5575 to Kapuaipoopoo;
5. Thence southwesterly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated September 11, 1912, the boundary follows along the land of Pelekunu, R.P. 7262, L.C.Aw. 5575 to Kapuaipoopoo to the edge of Pali;

6. Thence southeasterly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated September 11, 1912, the boundary follows along the edge of pali between the Government Land of Waikolu and the land of Pelekunu; R.P. 7262, L.C.Aw. 5575 to Kapuaipoopoo to a point at junction of ridges called Ohialele;
7. Thence southwesterly along Molokai Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated September 11, 1912, the boundary follows along the edge of Pelekunu Valley between the Government Land of Waikolu and the land of Pelekunu, R.P. 7262, L.C.Aw. 5575 to Kapuaipoopoo to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 1330 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.
