

## Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes


By this Executive Order, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR NATURAL AREA RESERVE, to be under the control and management of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii, being the lands situate at Kipahoeheo, South Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, and designated as KIPAHOEHOE NATURAL AREA RESERVE, containing a gross area of 5,594.2 Acres, and a net area of 5,583.2 Acres, more or less, after excluding and deducting therefrom, Mamalahoa Highway, all more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibits being, respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 19,619 and dated October 15, 1982.


SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

Being a portion of the Government Land of Kipahoehoe.

Beginning at the northwest corner of this parcel of land, on the east side of jeep trail and on the boundary between the lands of Kaapuna and Kipahoehoe, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KIPAHOEHOE" being 3071.51 feet North and 3770.62 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

4. 317° 02' 3244.00 feet along Grant 2791 to C. C. Harris;
5. 76° 47' 24,624.00 feet along Government Land of Alika and along Grant 5045 to J. Deniz;
6. 99° 03' 1570.50 feet along Grant 3153 to Makia and Keaweikaliko;
7. 83° 23' 2190.00 feet along Grant 3153 to Makia and Keaweikaliko;
8. 100° 59' 1638.00 feet along Grant 3153 to Makia and Keaweikaliko;
9. 93° 32' 2182.00 feet along Grant 3153 to Makia and Keaweikaliko;
10. 87° 44' 10" 4900.00 feet along Grant 3153 to Makia and Keaweikaliko to the east side of jeep trail;

Thence along the remainder of the Government Land of Kipahoehe, along the east side of jeep trail, the direct azimuth and distance being: 186° 32' 34" 10,147.77 feet to the point of beginning and containing a GROSS AREA OF 5594.2 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, and a NET AREA OF 5583.2 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, after excluding and deducting therefrom, Mamalahoa Highway, Federal Aid Project No. 8-A (11.0 Acres).





## SETTING ASIDE LAND FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11 and Section 195-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR ADDITION TO THE KIPAOEHOE NATURAL AREA RESERVE, to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife, being that parcel of land situate at Alika and Papa



1st, South Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, identified as "Portion of the Government Lands of Alikā and Papa 1st," containing an area of 171.823 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 24,427 and dated April 9, 2007.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.
