



APPLICATION FOR COMMERCIAL USE OF HAWAIIAN THREATENED AND ENDANGERED PLANT SPECIES Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 107

This application is for Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) approval of commercial use of Threatened and Endangered plants. "Commercial use" is defined as the transfer of a plant for a fee, charge, or other compensation. Plants may only be sold if accompanied by a tag provided by DLNR. When approved, tags issued under this application must only be used for the plants listed in this document. The tag informs DLNR, vendors, and customers that each plant is approved for commercial use and was sourced from garden-grown stock and not from a wild population.

Each tag is \$0.10. We will contact you at the email address you enter below when the tags are ready to be picked up.
