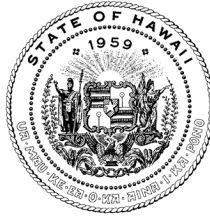

Submit written testimony (including meeting number, agenda item number, and testifier's name) not later than 24 hours prior to the meeting to ensure time for Commission review and for online posting with the meeting materials (email preferred, llcc@hawaii.gov**). Written testimony received fewer than 24 hours before the meeting will be retained for the administrative record and distributed to Commissioners and posted online as soon as practicable, but we cannot ensure that Commissioners will receive such late testimony with sufficient time for review prior to decision-making.*

Providing live/spoken testimony during the meeting (in-person, via ZOOM, or by telephone):

After the Commission completes its initial discussion of an agenda item, and before the Chairperson calls for a motion from the Commission on that item, the Chairperson will call for public testimony, in the following order, or in another order established at the Chairperson's discretion:

1. Testifiers that submitted written testimony that the Commission received:
 - (a) not later than 24 hours before the meeting (called in the order received), and
 - (b) fewer than 24 hours before the meeting (called in the order received).
2. Testifiers that did not submit written testimony, and are participating:
 - (a) **in-person** (called in the order shown on the sign-in sheet provided at the in-person meeting location);
 - (b) **by telephone** (called in the order that testifiers unmute their telephone connection, **after** the Chairperson calls for testimony by telephone – press ***6** to unmute); and
 - (c) **online via ZOOM** (called in the order of names that testifiers type into the ZOOM chat window, **after** the Chairperson calls for testimony online via ZOOM).
