

HELP US STOP CRB!

REPORT CAPTURES & SIGHTINGS

Capture all CRB that you find! Place the beetle or grub in a glass or hard plastic container then call 643-PEST. CRB do not sting or bite but can carry bacteria so wear gloves when handling.

MANAGE GREEN WASTE

CRB can infest decomposing green waste including compost, mulch and dead palms.

- regularly turn and inspect compost piles.
- keep bags of planting material in closed containers.
- inform the CRB Response of dead palms.

REPORT DAMAGE

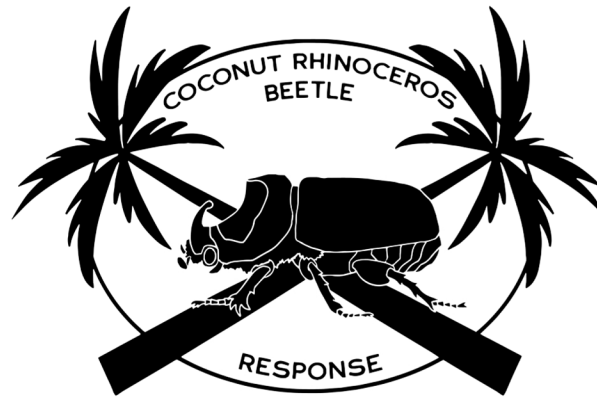
Look out for v-cut damage and boreholes on fronds. Take pictures of damage and report the location.

PROTECT TRAPS

Please do not disturb CRB traps. Report traps that have fallen or are damaged.
