

PREVENTION

- Enforcing quarantine regulations
- Generating pest risk assessments

DETECTION

Finding invasive species early:

 Implementing early detection surveys and rapid response (EDRR) approach

MANAGEMENT

- Implementing eradication projects, where possible
- Developing management projects, including Bio-Control






Challenges


