*“My fish is the Uhu or Parrotfish. The Uhu is important because it eats algae off corals. Some of the coral that it eats gets turned into sand.”*

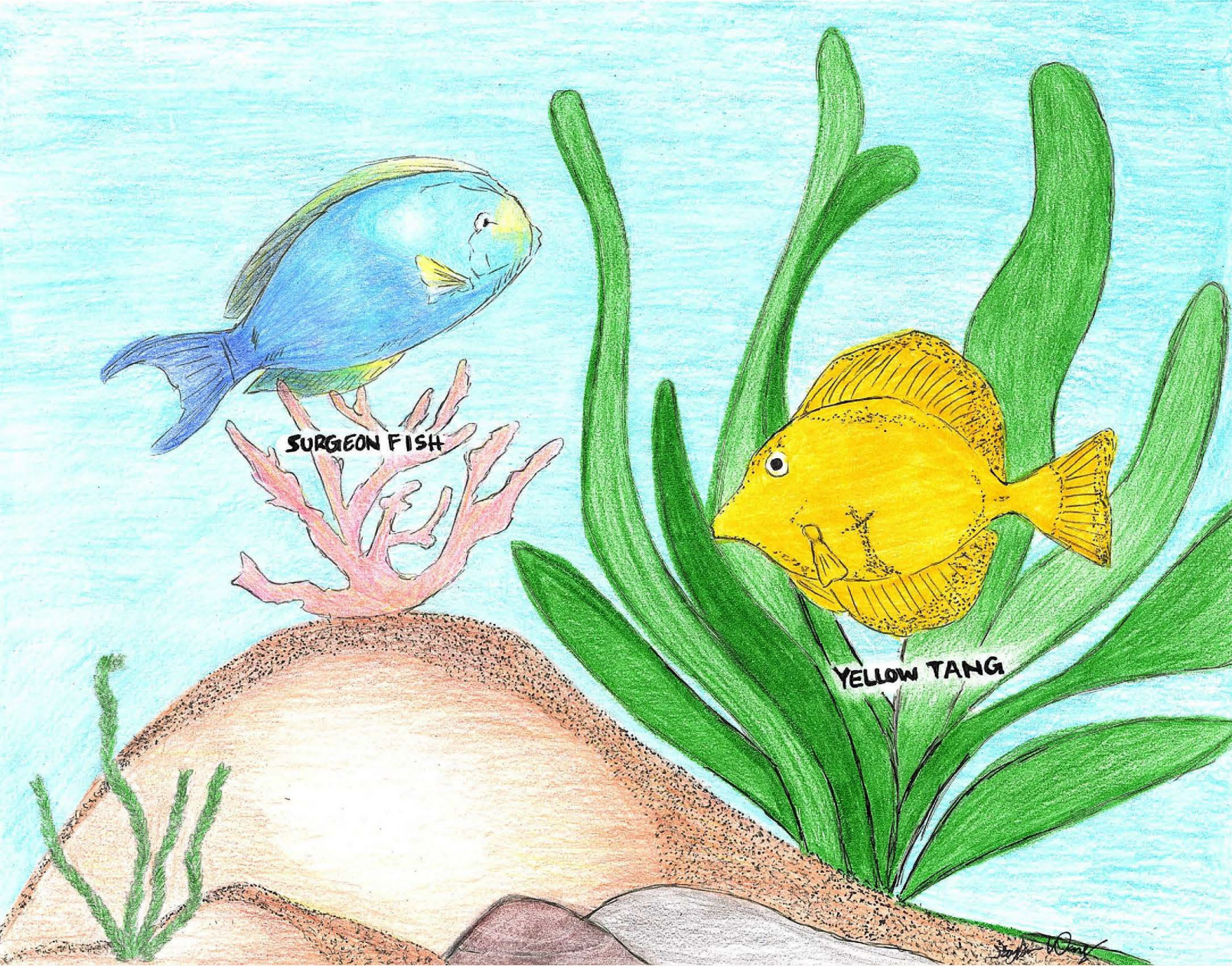
