Q What was the resource problem you were trying to solve?

A Nechu depletion in Harbor... Had them change regulations to scoop net and educate users and more.

Need to understand different languages (Culture, science and on and on...)

No Linau - LAHAINA - everything was depleted from front street to Lahaina harbor

Bridge science and CULTURE

Q What are the CHALLENGES?

A We did a conservation plan for Kahului harbor we invited EVERYONE to communicate with those who have not grown here educating people

Didn't have enough RESOURCES and didn't want to take away peoples rights BUT leave fish alone when spawning



Communication, Education (tourists don't know!!)

Q What does "Marine Management" mean to you?

MALAMA I Ke Kai Making sure we have enough to survive

A Maui waters are only managed at 3%

Q What is your opinion on what, where and how?

A We consider working with the communities like Kipahulu to see what can be done better or even more...

Work with communities that already have some systems in place... starting from scratch would take forever...

Q If this gets implemented how can it be managed? DLNR already has too much to do? Advice please...

A Managability isn't just DAR's problem. If you see people doing something wrong - EDUCATE them! Not solely DAR's responsibility

If we take and know better, we gotta inform those who don't know

It all falls on US!

What does it mean? you gon' close? A: example: Kshului, has regulations but not closed? Nav team will help dev plan

We not going to take away fishing! (maybe someplace need to rest?)

We Need to TALK about what we can do TOGETHER to make sure we can fish in the future!

DO YOUR HOMEWORK!

Find the truth. Lots of people talking about "rules" that are NOT happening.

We have to TALK and work together. Need to incentivize community
