Linnei - fresh water flow, **Muliwai navigation erosion control (lipo)**, **Opiki, papio, mullet**


SPECIES THRIVING: In my observations, these species of fish or marine life are thriving, and I believe these species are NOT being overfished or over-harvested.



What is the Maui Navigation Team? The Maui Navigation team will represent Maui ocean users who currently fish or engage with ocean resources from Maui's nearshore waters and who want to ensure future generations are able to do the same.

What will they do? They will work together as a team to review science, Maui data and community input, then set management goals and design a network of fishing regulations and management priorities for Maui's nearshore reef. (Management can include education, signage, enhanced outreach, restoration and additional monitoring.)



- no enforcement

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
