
Objection of the Protective Order file dated August 8, 2016

I Dwight J. Vicente, object to the motion for a protective order file dated August 8, 2016 by Douglas S. Chin and Harvey E. Henderson. I am objecting to these motions that were filed on August 8, 2016, which is well beyond the deadline of August 1, 2016. This deadline was firmly addressed by Riki May Amano on August 5, 2016 during the pre-hearing conference while denying Harry Fergstrom his request to continue filing motions. My objection is also based on The Hawaiian Kingdom still exist because The Reciprocity Treaty of 1875, as amended in 1887 was continued by the Republic of Hawaii in the 1894 Constitution Article 94. It was continued once more in 1898, Treaty of Annexation by The Republic of Hawaii and The U.S. Congress. All of the other treaties ended with the other nations and were replaced with U.S. Treaties, this act violates the U.S. Constitution, Article 1 Sec. 2 Clause 3, Taxation and representation 13 states only, no Amendments for any new states. The Organic Act of 1900 and The Admission Act of 1959 remain silent on the Reciprocity Treaty, therefore it must still exist because the U.S. continues to be present in this Kingdom, which I believe violates the U.S. Constitution. As a result of this, there can be no State of Hawaii within The Hawaiian Kingdom. The Hawaiian Kingdom and Japan's treaty ended in 1887. David Y. Ige, is a Japanese national, which gives

him no rights in this Kingdom and its affairs. He has no, immunity, Quo Warranto, who made him Governor? The office he claims, is a fraud. Suzanne Case and Stanley Roehrig, are also, not Nationals of this Kingdom, which also gives them no rights in this Kingdom and its affairs (including their claim to immunity). Because no authority exists, they should be made to answer for their actions. The case law sighted in their motion is limited to the 13 United States only, U.S. Courts have no jurisdiction over this Kingdom, by and through The Northwest Ordinance of 1787. Walter F. Frear stated by proclamation that Mauna Kea remains as Government Lands on June 5 1909, which he is correct about because Mauna Kea remains government lands belonging to The Hawaiian Kingdom. However, Walter F. Frear was appointed governor to the Territory of Hawaii by the President of the U.S., which also violates the U.S. constitution. The 1968 General Lease is based on Frear's proclamation of 1909 and there for is null and void. Should there be a lease granted it needs to be with this Kingdom. These individuals have no authority over Crown and Government lands. For the foregoing reasons their Motion for Protective Order should be denied.


