# GLEN KILA MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF TEMPLE OF LONO MOTION TO FILE MOTION OUT OF TIME

Comes now GLEN KILA to file my Memorandum in Support of Temple of Lono Motion to File Motion Out of Time.

The Temple of Lono filed a motion to file a motion out of time. DOC-179.

The challenge by the Temple to the Applicant's qualifications to receive the permit at issue in this proceeding is profound and disturbing.

The question before the Hearing Officer is whether there is a good reason to allow the filing of the motion to dismiss that the Temple seeks to file out of time.

The question seems to be answered by considering the nature of the pleading that forms the basis for the Temple's motion. DOC-135. The University describes the Temple of Lono as follows:

- (1) The organization can be deemed a religious organization. DOC-135 at 15.
- (2) The organization is "fundamentally adversarial (and ardently absolutist)." <u>Ibid.</u> at 14.
  - (3) The organization is intolerant and unable to compromise weld.

(4) When "confronted with a conflict between cooperation and conformity to

doctrine," the organization "invariably chooses" conformity to doctrine. <u>Id</u>.

(5) The organization chooses conformity to doctrine "regardless of the harm

it brings to the society of which it is a part." Id.

The Hearing Officer can take note that, since 9/11, the public has been told

that religious fundamentalists intent on imposing their beliefs on others are

harming the societies of which they are a part in pursuit of their fundamentalist

agenda. Such organizations are clearly portrayed and perceived as a threat.

As a practitioner of the indigenous Hawaiian religion called Kanenuiakea, I

am religiously offended by the University's attack.

How can the University be trusted with the responsibility to protect Native

Hawaiian customary and traditional rights, including the right to practice the

Traditional Hawaiian Faith, when the University demeans the faith that they would

be obligated to protect?

They cannot.

The Temple motion to file out of time should be granted, so that the Hearing

Officer can take up the Temple's Motion to Dismiss and dismiss the Application.
