I J. Leina'ala Sleightholm submit this motion to Amend Minute Order No. 18 (Doc. 274) issued by the Hearings Officer, Judge Riki Mae Amano (Ret.) on September 19, 2016, and request the following changes to this Minute Order for the following reasons.

1. Logistics: The current meeting place is at 10:00 a.m. at Hilo Bayfront. I live in Waikoloa, and this would cause a burden upon me in time, as it would only take me approximately 45 minutes to get to Mauna Kea from here, versus over an hour to Hilo, and the same amount of time back. We have children we need to pick up in Kona in the afternoon, and cannot spend the extra time driving to Hilo. It would also cause a financial strain on us to have to travel the extra distance. For those reasons I would request that we meet at Hale Pohaku at 10:00 a.m. instead of Hilo Bayfront.

2. Principle: I very much mahalo the Hearings Officer for making arrangements and accommodations for travel, however, I do not agree with, and have opposed the tour vans/busses on Mauna Kea, and cannot travel in them. I continue to request taking my own vehicle with my husband, Adam Sleightholm as my driver.

I'm requesting to be able to take photographs, and video recordings during this site visit, as this site visit pertains to my arguments and participation in the contested case hearing.
