OF THE TEMPLE OF LONO


I, FRANK TAMEHAMEHA KAMEHALOHA NOBRIGA, declare the following to be true and correct:

1. I am the Kahuna of the Temple of Lono.
2. At the second prehearing conference in this proceeding held on June 17, 2016, the Hearing Officer raised questions about whether Mr. Lanny Alan Sinkin could represent the Temple of Lono in this proceeding.
3. While the Temple submitted a Statement of Representation pursuant to HAR 13-1-10, which documented that I had authorized Mr. Sinkin to represent the Temple of Lono, the Hearing Officer did not find Mr. Sinkin's position as a lay member of the Temple to satisfy that rule.
4. After discussion between Mr. Sinkin and the Hearing Officer, the Hearing Officer agreed that Mr. Sinkin could represent the Temple, if the Kahuna of the Temple appointed Mr. Sinkin as an officer.
5. At that point in the prehearing conference, I did rise, come forward, and appoint Mr. Sinkin an officer.

6. Based on that appointment, the Hearing Officer permitted Mr. Sinkin to represent the Temple of Lono.

7. The Hearing Officer also requested that the Temple file a declaration noting that appointment.

8. I herein declare that I have appointed Mr. Lanny Alan Sinkin as an officer in the Temple of Lono.
