Based upon information I received today, I am submitting this Third Supplemental Disclosure relating to my serving as the Hearing Officer in the above-referenced contested case hearing. Two independent disclosures are set out below.

Stanley Roehrig, Esq. This morning I received a telephone call from Andrew Wilson, Esq. regarding a case I mediated commencing in 2005-06. Mr. Wilson and Stanley Roehrig, Esq., his law partner, represented dozens of plaintiffs in Civil No. 03-01-0226 (3rd Circuit) and Civil No. 03-1-0152 (3rd Circuit). There were multiple other parties in the two quiet title cases.

The Wilson/Roehrig Plaintiffs entered into a Settlement Agreement in 2010. However, in reviewing his files over this past weekend, Mr. Wilson found that the issue of his clients' PASH rights with another named party, remained to be resolved; thus his call to me this morning requesting mediation assistance.

I advised Mr. Wilson that I would be making a disclosure to the DLNR about my involvement in this case since Mr. Roehrig serves on the Board of Land and Natural Resources. Mr. Wilson advised me that Mr. Roehrig will be withdrawing as counsel.

Under the circumstances, I do not believe any reasonable person would consider my longstanding service as a mediator in Civil Nos. 03-1-0226 and 03-1-0152, to affect my impartiality as a hearings officer for this contested case hearing.

Richard N. Wurdeman, Esq. In the course of my duties as the Executive Director of Maximum Legal Services Corporation ("MaxCorp"), I participated in a meeting between MaxCorp's attorney and a client this morning. MaxCorp is the court-appointed conservator for

this particular client. The client shared that he was recently represented in a district court matter by Attorney Richard N. Wurdeman.

The conservatorship and district court case are two entirely distinct legal matters and MaxCorp would not be working together with Mr. Wurdeman on the client's behalf. However, it is likely that Mr. Wurdeman's legal services would be paid by MaxCorp as the client's conservator. As the Executive Director, I would not be directly involved.

I do not believe my position as MaxCorp's Executive Director and Mr. Wurdeman's representation of his client, would cause any reasonable person to think that my impartiality as the hearings officer for this contested case hearing would be affected.
