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Pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes §13-1-10, the Temple of Lono provides this statement regarding representation in the above-captioned proceeding.


To date in this proceeding, Mr. Lanny Alan Sinkin has represented the Temple of Lono as a lay representative. . See DOC-50 and DOC-72.
