Statement Designating Witnesses

Petitioner Kalikolehua Kanaele submits this Statement Designating Witnesses pursuant to Minute Order No. 16 filed August 22, 2016 (DOC. 238), Minute Order No. 21, filed October 11th, 2016 (DOC. 244), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) 91-10, Hawaii Administrative Rule (HAR) 13-1-32, and oral orders issued by the Hearing Officer at the pre-hearing conference on October 3, 2016 in Hilo, Hawaii.

I. Designation of Witnesses for Cross-Examination

As provided for in Minute Orders No. 16 and 21:

I wish to cross-examine all other parties' witnesses, including, but not limited to the witnesses of: Applicant the University of Hawai'i at Hilo (UHH), the TMT International Observatory, Inc (TIO), and Perpetuating Unique Educational Opportunities (P.U.E.O.) as designated below.

- A. Designation of all UHH Witnesses for Cross-Examination included on their Final Witness List, as well as any other witnesses called by UHH.
- B. Designation of all TIO Witnesses for Cross-Examination included on their Final Witness List, as well as any other witnesses called by TIO.
- C. Designation of all P.U.E.O. Witnesses for Cross-Examination included on their Final Witness List, as well as any other witnesses called by P.U.E.O.
- D. Designation of other parties' Witnesses for Cross-Examination included on their Final Witness List, as well as any other witnesses that may be called.

II. Designation of Rebuttal Witness Evidence

After reading the Rebuttal witnesses of No More Desecration Petitioners: I may call or let the rebuttal witnesses of the No More Desecration Petitioners for countering evidence received by the contested case proceedings and the content of direct witness testimonies. HRS 91-10(3) provides, "Every party shall have the right to conduct such cross-examination as may be

required to submit rebuttal evidence.” See Also HAR 13-1-32(g) (providing for parties’ right to submit rebuttal evidence). I therefore submit the reasoning above.

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
