**STATEMENT OF J. LEINA'ALA SLEIGHTHOLM
DESIGNATING WITNESSES**

I, J. Leina'ala Sleightholm, respectfully submit this Statement Designating Witnesses in accordance with Minute Order No. 16, filed August 22, 2016 (Doc. 238), Minute Order No. 21, filed October 11, 2016 (Doc. 244), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) 91-10, Hawaii Administrative Rule (HAR) 13-1-32, and oral orders issued by the Hearing Officer at the prehearing conference on October 3, 2016 at the Naniloa Crown Room, Hilo, Hawai'i.

I. Designation of Witnesses for Cross-Examination

As provided for in Minute Orders Nos. 16 and 21, I wish to cross-examine all other parties witnesses, including, but not limited to the witnesses of Applicant the University of Hawai'i at Hilo (UHH), the TMT International Observatory, Inc. (TIO), and Perpetuating Unique Educational Opportunities (P.U.E.O.) as designated below:

HRS 91-10(3) provides, "Every party shall have the right to conduct such cross-examination as may be required for a full and true disclosure of the facts, and shall have the right to submit rebuttal evidence." HAR 13-1-32(g) (providing for parties right to submit rebuttal evidence). I am submit my preliminary list of possible rebuttal witnesses, and reserve the right to submit other appropriate rebuttal evidence after arguments and testimonies are heard during the hearing.


