TEMPLE OF LONO SUPPLEMENT TO
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On August 6, the Temple of Lono filed its Motion For Extension Of Time For Filing Of Final Witness List And Prefiled Testimony, Exhibit List And Exhibits, Prehearing Statements, And Motions.

One of the reasons given by the Temple for its first request for an extension of time was the following:

The Temple of Lono is now required to respond to three separate proposed orders in a two-day period while preparing to meet the hearing related deadlines. See DOC-310, DOC-315, and DOC-318. The short time frame in which to deal with multiple proposed orders is unduly burdensome. The Temple requests three additional business days in which to respond to the three proposed orders.

Prior to the deadline for filing responses to the proposed motions, there was no ruling on the Temple's motion posted in the Document Library. The Temple has had to proceed for the last two days as if the extension of time would not be granted.

As a result, the Temple's representative spent seventeen hours preparing a thorough response to the three proposed orders. With very significant parts of the Temple's case facing dismissal, a comprehensive and fully explained objection to the proposed orders was necessary.

The Temple has now posted responses to the three proposed orders after spending most of the last two days preparing them.

Now the Temple faces the following:

A deadline of Tuesday, October 11 to file a final witness list, opening statement, prefiled testimony, exhibit list and exhibits, and any motions.

Monday, October 10 is a federal holiday, so the post offices will be closed. That essentially means the hard copies of the witness list, prefiled testimony, etc. have to be mailed on Saturday, October 8, i.e. tomorrow, to arrive in the DLNR offices by Tuesday.

There is no reason for this proceeding to be so rushed or burdensome, other than the predictable adverse impacts on those who oppose the permit being fully intended.

The Temple again urges the Hearing Officer to provide adequate time for all parties to be prepared for the Contested Case Hearing.
