On October 3, 2016 at the Crown Room at Naniloa 10:00 am to 1:00 pm, I William  
Freitas, approached the bench and gave an oral explanation for the record " Objecting" to  
hearing officer decision to set schedule with dates for Witness Testimonies, Exhibits and  
Pre-hearing Statements, Motions to reconsider, objections to motions, this schedule was  
PROPOSED, by attorney Lui Kwan for University of Hawaii outline for schedule ( like it  
was planned out, for that reason) I can only Speculate that a BIAS process was brewing.  
By the end of the hearing the Hearing Officer Followed every suggestion that was
