**STATEMENT OF MEHANA KIHOI DESIGNATING WITNESSES**

D. Designation of other parties' Witnesses for Cross-Examination included on they Fina Witness List, as well as any other witnesses that may be called.


## II. Designation of Rebuttal Witness Evidence
