II. ARGUMENT

In view of Doc B.30 CDUA HA-3568 Reinforces and states, Mauna Kea is a sacred place of worship for continued spiritual cultural religious practices of Native Hawaiian people, as such, Scattering of cremation remains, Ceremonies of Prayers and Offerings on AHU ("Stone Shrines") or up right POHAKU as markers of an particular area for Ohana ("Native Hawaiian Family") to Identify for Prayers and Offering Ceremonies for Placement of Piko ("Umbilical cord"), Placenta ("After Birth") and Burial Internment.

These Cultural Religious Spiritual Practices are Acts of Sacredness and should be Respected and Protected by laws set forth by the Hawaii State Agencies directly involved Such as BLNR and DOCARE officers.

III. Issues of Desecration

- 1. Continued efforts of desecration to Area of proposed development in north Ka'ohe platue by State Agencies and foreign development.
- 2. 2015 arrest of Native Hawaiians Protecting a sacred place of worship.
- **3.** August **25, 2015** bulldozing of AHU Kauakoko ("Stone Shrine") Recorded in Evidentiary Hearing Doc's T-3.k report to DOCARE.
- **4.** March 7, 2017 Litter Sanitation of Hale Kukia'i Mauna ("Place of Worship") Recorded in Evidentiary Hearing Doc's T-3.k2 and T-3.k3 report to DOCARE.

These Acts of Desecration are subjected to the statues of the State of Hawaii with

Obligation to BLNR and DOCARE enforcement agencies to take in account its

Responsibility for protection of the Laws that it is to enforce in reference to the issues

Stated above. These issues are in line with statues that protect religious practices, of Native Hawaiians and non-native hawaiians, along with protection of spiritual Religious places of worship and protection of sacred burial practices.

In closing, it will be most vital to the statues subjected to the State of Hawaii and its State agencies to take in account its integrity in making decisions for the applicant of the CDUA in consideration of the statues that have been violated, and recorded in these proceedings of this contested case hearing.
