# MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION

By Minute Order No. 44 [Doc. 553], the Hearing Offer determined what evidence would be received in the above-captioned proceeding. The Hearing Officer's ruling took into consideration the motions and objections made by the parties as set forth on pages 2 through 5 of Minute Order No. 44.

In consideration of objections made by Intervenor Cindy Freitas, that she "did not have an opportunity to cross-examine the exhibit tough [sic] Mr. Gosser or Ms. Collins," the Hearing Officer did not admit Applicant Exhibit A-142. Minute Order No. 44 at 16. Applicant hereby moves for reconsideration of that ruling.

Exhibit A-142 is the Archaeological Monitoring Plan In Support of Construction of the Thirty Meter Telescope in the Astronomy Precinct on Mauna Kea, dated May 2013. Although, Mr. Gosser and Ms. Collins were not presented as witnesses, their written direct testimonies are not the sole basis for admission of Exhibit A-142 into evidence. Rather, Exhibit A-142 was introduced into evidence through the cross-examination of Ms. Tiffnie Kakalia on Hearing Day 41, for which Ms. Freitas was present. *See* Ex. 1, Tr. 02/27/17 at 3, 202-203.

Exhibit A-142 was therefore improperly excluded, as it is relevant to the issues presented in this proceeding and does not fall into any of the categories for denial upon which the Hearing

Officer articulated. Importantly, Ms. Kakalia was asked several questions concerning the contents of Exhibit A-142. If it is excluded, the record of Ms. Kakalia's testimony will be incomplete.

In light of the foregoing, Applicant moves the Hearing Officer to reconsider Minute Order No. 44 to admit Exhibit A-142 into evidence.
