Comes now, Brannon Kamahana Kealoha with a motion pleading for more time to submit my FOF, a motion moving to joinder all petitioners FOFs recommending denial of permit for the TMT construction and another motion of joinder to all petitioners recommending denial of permit in regards to every single one of said petitioner's requests, motions, memos, and amendments since 12/8/17 including, but not limited to, all items ruled upon and the many not ruled upon by the honorable Hearing Officer.

1) Since being under what I have made known as duress and coercion, due to the largely dictated schedule, the completely dictated and restricted location of this hearing exclusively in Hilo, Hawaii, my ongoing life threatening medical conditions (see attached), the bird mite infestation in my home caused largely by my attendance in these dictated scheduled hearings exclusively in Hilo, Hawaii (see attached), I have been unable to conform to the Hearing Officer's schedule despite being informed of these dates, times and exclusive location.

2) Attachments I am submitting herein evidence the above insurmountable pro se items that have never been addressed or accommodated and have deprived me of rights of due process and more as a pro se, unable to afford representation. It is my understanding that the wording and documents that support the passing of law that created this hearing process state that this

contested hearing process was created to protect pro se rights. This has not been the case in my perspective and I plead the hearing officer give more time to complete my findings of facts, allow me to joinder petitioners aforementioned, in like mind and motion, and therefore fulfill the purpose and reasons this contested hearing process was set up for- to protect pro se rights, which thus far has failed to be fulfilled in my case and perhaps in others.

All documents attached are confidential and the Records Officer should take heed as I am submitting redacted pdfs for public upload and non-redacted copies for official use only.

3) I will also assert that like many off island practitioners, my lineal iwi are known and historically documented as submitted in my initial petition. I assert that the Poliahu heiau is on Kaua'i and that is evidence enough, among much evidence that Mauna Kea's summit is as the old folks would say in Hawaiian, the Piko of ALL the land. I will also assert that I believe that Maelani Lee and Glenn Kila were subjugated similarly and evidence the same non-accommodating of pro se I am proffering here as a discrepancy in law. I believe those that do not have the luxury to hire legal support, the pro se, have not been accommodated and that furthermore Hearing Officer's witness Moses Kealamakia has also not been accommodated like myself. This hearing process again was established to protect the rights of pro se, those that cannot AFFORD to participate. I want to remember and honor those of us who do not have the luxury of having the hearings 100 miles away but instead are subjugated by a round trip to Hilo amounting to nearly 500 miles distance. I live here in Nanakuli because this is where my work and subsistence is. I live simultaneously in the land of my ancestors, where my iwi are laid to "rest," Waimea, Hamakua, Kohala, South Kona and the summits of Mauna Kea and I forever assert my rights and subjugation at this point affected by the lack of support this hearing process was set up distinctly to address. My rights have not been upheld in this hearing. And neither have the rights of my iwi, documented in your adjudicated court system in Magoon vs. Kahunaaina, my tutu Lilinoe and Kukahauula who were real people and are my direct lineage, and have been further deified in their passing and interment. I seek redress and relief as protected by law and what is definitely in the purview and scope of the Hearing Officer to remedy. This is my pleadings.

4) Given all of the above stated in item one, and evidenced in the attachments accompanying this "pleading for more time" and "motion to joinder all petitioners FOFs recommending denial of permit for TMT construction" and "motion to joinder all petitioners recommending denial of permit in regards to every single one of said petitioner's requests, motions, memos, and amendments since 12/8/17 including, but not limited to, all items ruled upon and the many not ruled upon by the honorable Hearing Officer" I humbly motion the hearing officer and make my requests to all above formally. If there be any error in my communication, given my pro se status, I plead that the powers that be do the right thing and allow my motions as well as guide me through the process you are stewards of.
