Eco-system shift (e.g. dredging wetlands)

Major change (over 50%) in the dimensions of the original structure

Activities that will impact protected species or critical habitat

Activities that will impact beach processes

Excavations

Pre-consultation with Army Corps of Engineers

Pre-consultation with DLNR

Develop Best Management Practices

Loko i`a permit application (extended)

Determine if project is eligible for a Nationwide Permit 3, or if an individual Army Corps permit is needed.
