Respondent TMT International Observatory LLC ("TIO") hereby submits its response to

Petitioners Mauna Kea Hui's Motion to Modify Minute Order No. 6 ("Motion"). TIO has no

objection to rescheduling the October 6, 2023 hearing on the Petition given counsel's scheduling

conflict. If the Board's preference is to reschedule the hearing on the Petition to another date in

October, TIO's counsel, Ross T. Shinyama, Esq., is available on October 5, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20,

23, 24 and 31. Unfortunately, Mr. Shinyama will be traveling on the mainland for business

during the Board's regularly scheduled meetings in October. Upon request, Mr. Shinyama can provide the Board with his availability for November and December 2023.

In the Motion, Petitioners request they be permitted 20 minutes for argument, instead of 15 minutes. Petitioners state they have no objection to the University of Hawai'i at Hilo having 20 minutes, but that all other parties, including TIO, should be limited to 15 minutes. Though TIO believes that 15 minutes should be sufficient for all parties to present their arguments, TIO does not object to the Board extending the time for oral argument from 15 minutes to 20 minutes for each party if it believes the extra time is appropriate. However, contrary to the inequitable position advocated by Petitioners, the allotted time should be the same for all parties. Either all parties have 15 minutes or all parties have 20 minutes. Moreover, Petitioners' attempt to limit the argument time for TIO and its counsel should be rejected. Indeed, this Board recognized the importance of TIO to this Petition when it stated in Minute Order No. 6 that TIO would argue first for Respondents.

Petitioners also request that the hearing on the Petition be held in-person as opposed to via Zoom. Initially, the Board has the discretion to hold this hearing via Zoom. Petitioners do not cite to a single authority that would require an in-person hearing. Given this, TIO leaves it to the Board's discretion as to whether this hearing should be held in-person or via Zoom.

Finally, Petitioners request Minute Order No. 6 be amended or supplemented to reflect that the originally scheduled July 28, 2023 hearing was rescheduled at Mr. Shinyama's request. TIO believes this is unnecessary as the record is clear as to the circumstances that ultimately resulted in the rescheduling of the July 28, 2023 hearing.
