



Application Instructions for the
Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau National Historical Park Goat Salvage Program

1. The application is for one (1) salvage permittee with a truck and trailer only.
2. Be sure to **PRINT all information** clearly in the spaces provided for **each** applicant, using **each applicant's own personal mailing address**.
3. Applicants must indicate how many goats they wish to receive. Applicants will be required to take a minimum of 20 and up to a maximum of 50.
4. The **DEADLINE** for all applications to be submitted to the **Division of Forestry and Wildlife Office, 66-1220 A Lalamilo Road, Kamuela HI. 96743 at 3:30 pm on Wednesday, July 21, 2021** (this is when the DOFAW office will close) or postmarked by that day by the U.S. Postal Service.
5. The **PUBLIC DRAWING** to assign a time slot for the for all qualified applicants for the Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau National Historical Park Goat Salvage Program will be held in the Kamuela DOFAW Office, 66-1220 A Lalamilo Road, Kamuela, HI. 96743 on **Wednesday, July 28, 2021 at 11:00 am**. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the lottery will be closed to the public. Depending on the number of applicants, not all may be drawn for the salvage. There will be no stand-by list. Results will be mailed, made available on-line, and will be available in the Kamuela Office.
6. Applicants will be drawing to salvage goats on August 11, 2021. The drawing will be for 30-minute time slots, beginning at 8:00 a.m. with the final slot to be at 3:00 p.m.
7. All permittees that are drawn must arrive at the Puu Honua o Honaunau National Historic Park gate at the time that they are assigned.
