2. NPS & DLNR Proposal for Implementing Mosquito Control on East Maui

Chris Warren, the Forest Bird Program Coordinator for Haleakalā National Park, discusses the proposal to release *Wolbachia*-incompatible mosquitoes in areas of East Maui in order to reduce vector-borne disease transmission to Hawaiian Honeycreepers. Chris discusses how

implementation of the Incompatible Insect Technique could reduce abundance of the Southern house mosquito (*Culex quinquefasciatus*) and methods for deploying incompatible male mosquitoes within Haleakalā National Park and several state managed reserves on East Maui. NPS and DLNR have collaborated to develop an Environmental Assessment for the project and request public input on how to mitigate potential impacts and address concerns regarding implementation on popular hunting and recreational use areas.
