**PRIVATE LANDOWNERS ON MAUI NUI SOUGHT TO ASSIST AXIS
DEER CONTROL**

KAHULUI, Maui – Axis deer continue to harm Maui Nui's forested watersheds, farmland, and communities. To address these issues, the DLNR Division of Forestry and Wildlife (DOFAW) is encouraging qualified private landowners and lessees to apply for the Landowner Incentive Program (LIP) to help manage deer populations responsibly.

This program aims to motivate landowners on Maui, Moloka'i, and Lāna'i to remove more axis deer from their properties and improve protection efforts for the state's threatened natural and agricultural resources. Applicants awarded a contract can receive up to \$50 for each qualifying deer tail they submit. Awards depend on the availability of funds.

All axis deer harvest and control must comply with applicable laws, including [Hawai'i Administrative Rules Chapter 123, Rules Regulating Game Mammal Hunting](#).

The deadline to submit proposals is February 15, 2026, at 4 p.m. Once approved, the LIP for each participant is 12 months. Compensation for deer in any given fiscal year is limited to the annual legislative appropriation for the program, and no additional payments will be made once the funding is exhausted. This is the final opportunity to participate in this fiscal year.

Watershed partnerships spend hundreds of thousands of dollars each year building fences to prevent feral ungulates from trampling native plants. If left unchecked, axis deer will gradually decrease overall forest health. Recent harvest rates indicate a promising trend toward reducing environmental and economic damage to property and land, as well as lowering the overall deer population.
